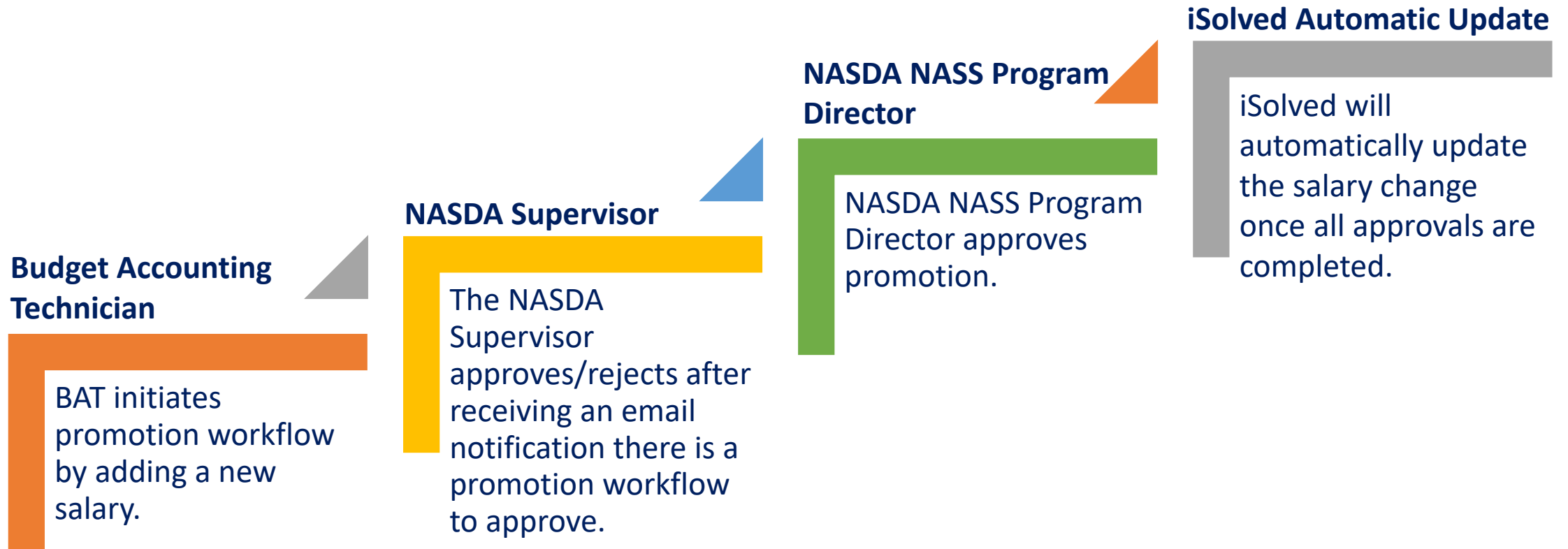

Promotion Workflow Chart



Workflow Overview

1. Budget and Accounting Technicians (BATs) run the *Service & Promotion Report* in iSolved as they normally would in order to determine when employees are eligible for a promotion.
2. When an employee becomes eligible for a promotion, the Budget & Accounting Technician initiates a promotion workflow in iSolved.
3. The NASDA Supervisor receives an email notification asking them to login to iSolve and approve or reject your enumerator's promotion.
 - Supervisors should approve or reject the promotion *within the pay period they become eligible.*
 - All rejected promotions must have a brief explanation of why the promotion is being denied, *including a future date to review again.*
 - Supervisors enter their explanation under the area for "Notes."
 - *Remember: If an enumerator does not have an evaluation on file, the promotion should be rejected until an evaluation is completed.*
4. NASS Program Director Charlie Ingram receives an email to approve or reject the promotion.
5. The workflow and enumerator's new salary and pay rate will automatically be updated in iSolved. The process is complete and there is nothing more supervisors need to do!

With this new promotion workflow/tool, along with the Performance Evaluations already in iSolved, this will replace forms NAS-002, NAS-006, and NAS-013.
