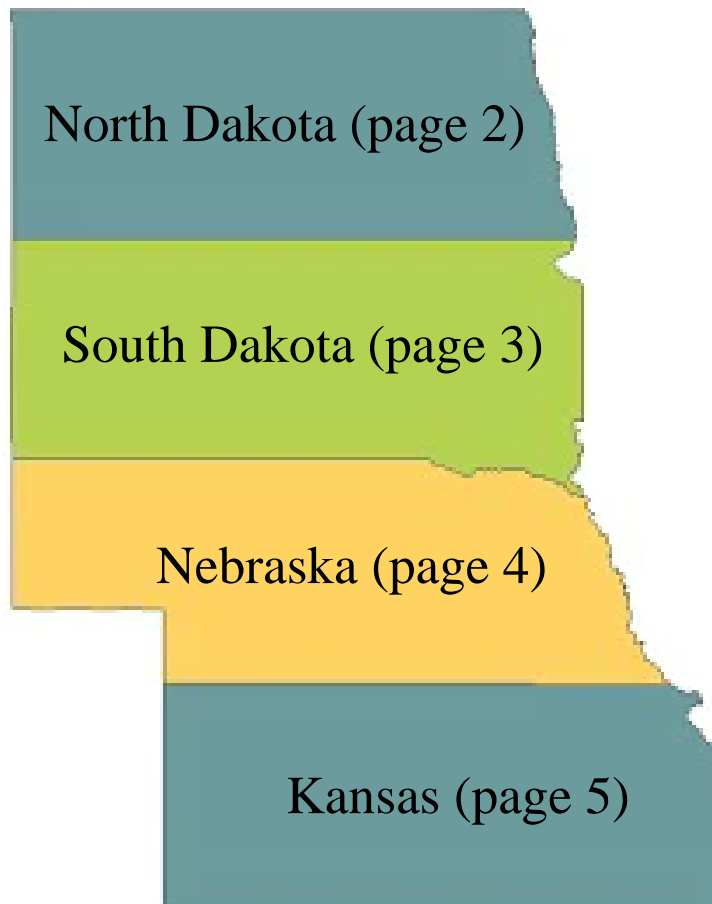



Eggs (75,000 or fewer laying hens are exempt)	\$0.10 per 30 dozen
Honey (250,000 lbs or less are exempt)	\$0.015 per pound

Calculating Check-Off Amounts

CORN

Take # of Bushels sold times 0.01
25,000 bushels x 0.01 = \$250.00

SOYBEANS

Take Market Value times 0.005
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
25,000 bushels x \$12.05/bu x 0.005 = \$1,506.25

WHEAT

Take Market Value times 0.02
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
25,000 bushels x \$7.24/bu x 0.02 = \$3620.00

SORGHUM

Take Market Value times 0.006
5,000 CWT x \$5.75/cwt x 0.006 = \$172.50

To convert Bushels to CWT:
Take # of bushels times 56 and then divide that by 100
(25,000 bushels x 56) / 100 = 14,000 CWT

Calculating Check-Off Amounts

CORN

Take # of Bushels sold times 0.005
25,000 bushels x 0.005 = \$125.00

SOYBEANS

Take Market Value times 0.005
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
25,000 bushels x \$12.05/bu x 0.005 = \$1,506.25

WHEAT

Take Market Value times 0.004
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
25,000 bushels x \$7.24/bu x 0.004 = \$724.00

SORGHUM

Take # of CWT sold times 0.01
Take Market Value times 0.006
5,000 CWT x 0.01 = \$50.00
5,000 CWT x \$5.75/cwt x 0.006 = \$172.50
\$50.00 + \$172.50 = \$222.50

To convert Bushels to CWT:
Take # of bushels times 56 and then divide that by 100
(25,000 bushels x 56) / 100 = 14,000 CWT
14,000 CWT x 0.01 = \$140.00

CORN

Take Market Value (of grain) times 0.0025
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
\$50,000 x 0.0025 = \$125.00

SOYBEANS

Take Market Value times 0.005
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
25,000 bushels x \$12.05/bu x 0.005 = \$1,506.25

WHEAT

Take # of Bushels Sold times 0.015
25,000 bushels x \$0.015 = \$375.00

South Dakota
Calculating Check-Off Amounts

CORN

Take # of Bushels sold times 0.01
25,000 bushels x 0.01 = \$250.00

SOYBEANS

Take Market Value times 0.005
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
25,000 bushels x \$12.05/bu x 0.005 = \$1,506.25

WINTER OR SPRING WHEAT

Take Market Value times 0.0034
(# of Bushels times \$Price)
25,000 bushels x \$5.24/bu x 0.0034 = \$445.40

SORGHUM

Take Market Value times 0.006
5,000 CWT x \$5.75/cwt x 0.006 = \$172.50

To convert Bushels to CWT:
Take # of bushels times 56 and then divide that by 100
(25,000 bushels x 56) / 100 = 14,000 CWT
14,000 CWT x 0.006 = \$84.00
