The National Association of State Departments of Agriculture urges Congress to pass H.R. 10445, the "Further Continuing Appropriations and Disaster Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2025."

Real incomes are being throttled by persistently high input costs and depressed commodity prices while opportunities to invest in the future are hampered by prohibitive interest rates.
