# **Overview of Semi-Annual Cattle Survey**

Project Codes: January - 150

July - 152

**Purpose:** Collects inventory, death, and disposition data semi-annually in January and July. Collect annual inventory values and on farm slaughter numbers. The sample is selected based on total number of cattle, further classified by total milk cows and cattle on feed capacity.

### Data Uses:

- Producers can use cattle inventory data to make informed business decisions and plan for head expansion or reduction.
- Processors, warehouses, transportation companies, and government leaders use the data to evaluate expected slaughter volume for future months and determine potential supplies for export.
- Financial institutions use cattle reports in serving the producer's credit needs.

## **Survey Information:**

- Cattle numbers are published by state each January. In July, only national inventories are published.
- If an operation does not have cattle, follow the screening questions and make sure to ask cattle intentions. Do NOT select the "Out of Business" option in the survey comments.
- (IA/MN Only) Relationship to Cattle on Feed Report in January and July
  - Steers, other heifers, and calves in inventory must include all cattle on feed reported in the steers (660) and heifers (666) on the cattle on feed questionnaire.
  - The "Cattle and Calves on Feed" inventory is recorded on the cattle on feed questionnaire in the cattle on feed inventory (652).
  - The "Cattle and Calves on Feed" capacity is recorded on the January cattle on feed questionnaire in the cattle on feed total capacity (676).
