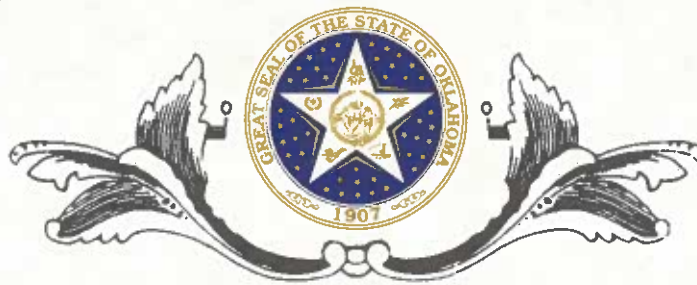

Whereas, Oklahoma stands as a leader in agricultural production and exports in the United States, providing a vast array of products that are critical both domestically and internationally; and

Whereas, Oklahoma's leading agriculture exports include but are not limited to beef, wheat, pork, cotton, and poultry; and

Whereas, the enhancement of trade relations and the development of new trade agreements are vital for the continued growth and success of Oklahoma's agricultural sector; and

Whereas, it is imperative to raise awareness among consumers, businesses, and policymakers about the challenges and opportunities facing agricultural trade;

Now Therefore, I, Governor J. Kevin Stitt, do hereby proclaim March 19, 2025, as

"Oklahoma Agriculture Trade Day"
