#### Cold Storage Overview

- Conducted since 1914, after allegations that food speculators were "cornering the market" to drive up prices
- Provides information on national supplies of food in refrigerated storage facilities that normally store food products for 30+ days
- Information is used by warehouse operators, food processors, people servicing the warehouse and processing industries, and government agencies.





# Cold Storage Survey

#### • Monthly

- Reference Date: Last day of the month
- Data Collection Dates: End of previous month approx. the 14<sup>th</sup> of the current month
- Same questionnaire each month
- Release Date: 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the month
- Biennial
  - Refrigerated Warehouse Capacity
  - Every 2 years in the fall
  - Screens operations for the monthly survey







### Monthly Cold Storage Survey

- Split into 7 Sections
  - Dairy Products
  - Pecans
  - Frozen Fruit & Concentrated Juice
  - Frozen Vegetables
  - Frozen Eggs
  - Frozen Poultry
  - Frozen Meat & Meat Products











## Monthly Cold Storage Survey

- Each commodity is reported in pounds.
  - If other unit reported, leave a detailed comment.



• Leave comments for "other" or "unclassified" products.





### Monthly Cold Storage Survey

• Reference page 4 of the questionnaire for instructions.

1.REFRIGERATED STORAGE: Reports are needed for all storages, public or private, which are cooled artificially to 50 degrees F. or lower, where food commodities are normally stored for 30 days or more.	8.GREEN BEANS: Do not include whole green beans, Italian green beans or wax beans. These should be reported as other frozen vegetables.
2.STOCKS ON HAND: Report total stocks held under refrigeration in this storage at the end of the month, regardless of ownership or length of time held. Do not	9.PEAS, BLACKEYE: Do not include crowder peas, cream peas, or other southern types of peas. These should be reported as other frozen vegetables.

3.NATURAL CHEESE: Report under "Natural Cheese" blocks, barrels and other forms whether or not it may be subsequently converted to pasteurized processed cheese. Exclude processed cheese.	11.FROZEN BONELESS BEEF: Include all boxed boneless beef (i.e., ground beef, roasts, steaks, loins, strips, rounds, trimmings,) Do not include variety meats. See instruction 14.
4.GOVERNMENT OWNED STOCKS: Include quantities stored for the Commodity Credit Corporation Armed Forces and other Government agencies, including State and local governments.	12.FROZEN BEEF CUTS: All boxed primal beef cuts, bone-in. 13.PORK BELLIES: Include both skin-on and skinless

# Monthly Cold Storage Survey Specifics

- Facilities can be specialized or generalized.
- Most operations have a reporting arrangement.
- Call to complete the survey or remind the operator later in the survey period.
- Incomplete records do not need to be submitted in CAPI.
- Operation updates will need to be submitted in CAPI even if the operation is inaccessible.
