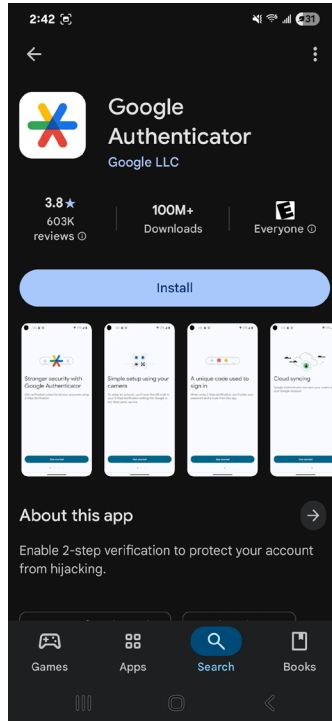
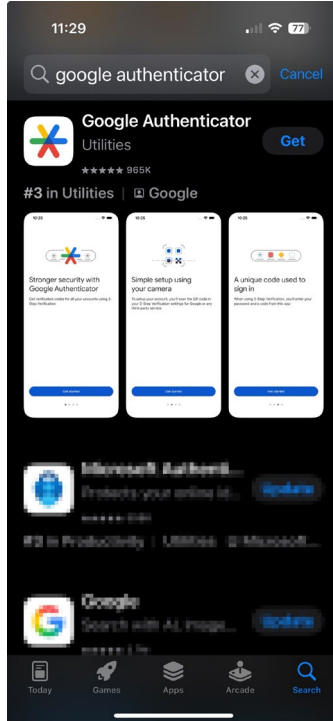


Adding an isolved Account to Google Authenticator

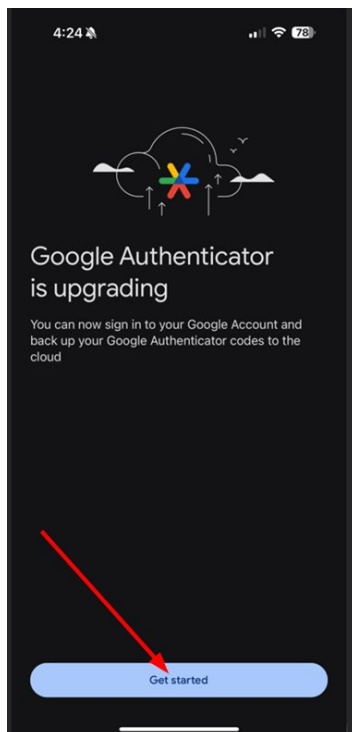
Step 1: Install Google Authenticator

- Download Google Authenticator from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.



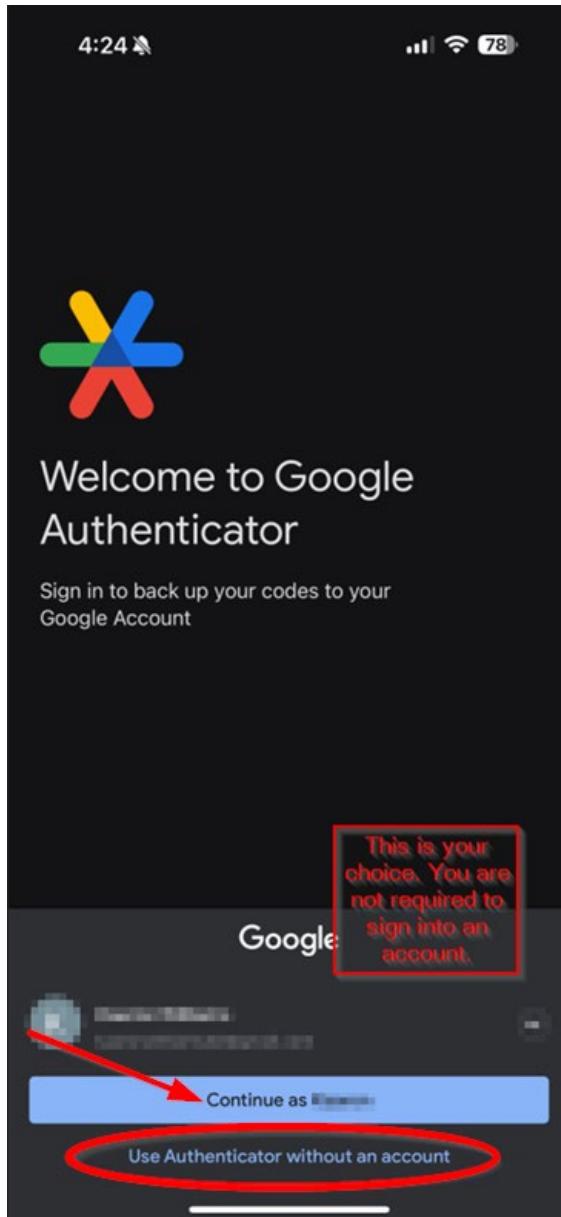
Step 2: Open the App

- Launch Google Authenticator on your device. Select **"Get Started"**.



Adding an isolated Account to Google Authenticator

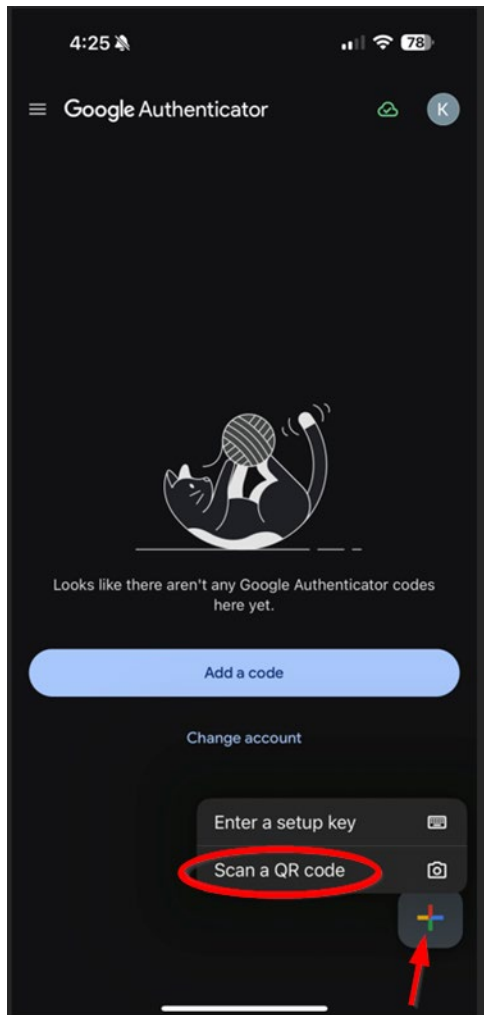
You may be asked to sign in to your Google account at this point (this will help back up your accounts to the cloud). However, you also have the option to “**Use Authenticator without an account**”.



Step 3: Add a New Account

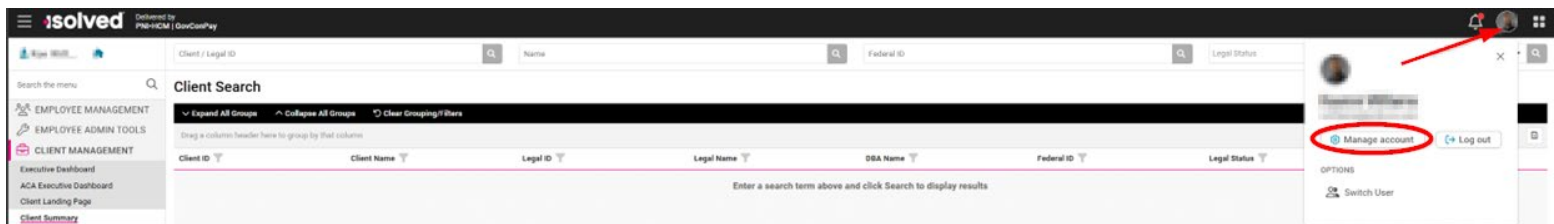
- Tap the “+” (plus) icon at the bottom right of the screen
- Choose Scan a QR code.

Step 4: Scan QR Code or Enter Code Manually

- On your computer, go to <https://payrollnetwork.myisolated.com>
- Navigate to your **Account Settings/Manage Account** and select **Change**.

Step 5: Complete the Setup

- Once the QR code is scanned and the isolated account will appear in your app. You'll now see a 6-digit code that refreshes every 30 seconds.
- Use this code to complete the MFA setup on the website. *Enter the code into the isolated box that is prompting for it.*
